

When my husband was in the hospital at St. Jude recently due to a heart attack, the importance of a priest hit home. Whether it is the comfort of praying before going in to surgery and stopping by afterwards or the emptiness felt by their absence, priests are with us at key moments of our lives, often when we are at our most vulnerable. On Priesthood Sunday this year please do something special for the priests in your life. Communicate your appreciation. I was with my husband in his hospital room as check out time drew near when a lady came around with a cart of various items. My husband asked me to select



an item since I could get closer to see what they had. "Choose one," she said. "We have ear plugs, mini Bibles.... My eye caught the perfect item. "I'll take that," I said. "That's the last one," she told me, as she handed it over. It was a plastic rosary with orange beads for the Hail Marys, green beads for the Our Fathers and a white cross. Perfect for my husband who always keeps a rosary in his pocket. Perfect for my husband who keeps his rosary in the

same pocket as his wallet and thus has on more than one occasion lost a rosary as it slipped to the ground unbeknownst to him as he took out his wallet to pay for something. Perfect for my husband and perfect for the next person who will find it on the floor of some store somewhere some day.

I cherished the encounter with touchstones of our faith in the brief time we were there at the hospital. I am so glad I'm Catholic.
