






On May First, 2025, our meeting date, Pope Francis was dead and the Conclave that named Cardinal Robert Prevost as Pope had yet to open. May First, 1955, was the first Memorial Day to St. Joseph the Worker. Then Pope Pius XII established the Memorial to Christianize the concept of labor and give to all workers a model and a protector.


Parallel Lives
